Fine+: Fine Plus (perforations well clear of the design; a middle range between F-VF and Fine).

Fine: (perforations clear the design).

Ave: Average (perforations touch or cut the design).

SD: Slightly Damaged (a presentable copy, but may have a thin, crease, pulled perf, etc.).

NH: Never Hinged Original Gum, Unmounted, Postfrisk.

The minor frame variations are consistent with the description by Nielsen, however, the center and right stamp show additional obvious varieties that I am surprised Nielsen did not mention: Center stamp with split upper left frame line and right stamp with missing portion of inner/thin lower right frame line. Wonderfully fresh and bright. [The 7 Cent Bicolor has a special distinction. The oval exists in four types; four copies of the mute master oval die were made and then the large 7 and the "7 CENTS." were each engraved, resulting in difference. This was the only Cents value that was manufactured in this way and of ALL the Danish and DWI bicolors, it is the only stamp which has variations of the large central number! THOMAS (postmark 22 mm with serifs, wide O; used 1880-83) to St. Croix with CHRISTIANSTED receiver (postmark 22 mm, with sans-serif letters and serified numbers; used 1870-80). Very nice example with usual light archival folding away from the stamp. Fresh and colorful. Facit 2011 SEK 4000 = \$580 [1/2011]. 390.00

234763 8 heavily damaged stamp on 4 July 1880 folded cover (no contents) from ST. THOMAS to St. Johns PUERTO RICO. Front of cover split nearly in half and with some tape stains, but looks nice. 2011 Facit value (in good condition) for the most common use of the 5 cent in this time is SEK 5000 = \$725 [1/2011]. A scarce cover that is actually fairly presentable despite its problems. Extremely low price. 35.00

234765 10, Facit #10e Print V (damaged) on 18 November 1891 cover from ST. THOMAS to Penn Yan (a village in central western New York state), with receiver. 2011 Facit value (in good condition) is SEK 3500 = \$510 [1/2011]. 40.00

215167 10 Print VI [10 Cent Perforation 14 Bicolor] (VF) on outstanding 24 November 1896 cover from ST. THOMAS to Denmark, with British transit and two Danish receivers on reverse. Remarkably fresh; this printing can be quite hard to find in such nice condition. (Facit 2010 value SEK 3500 = \$490.) 325.00

234766 10c, Facit #10g Print VII Inverted Frame (Fine) on 31 December 1899 cover from FREDERIKSTED to the U.S., with NY transit and NEWPORT, KENTUCKY receiver. Upper left corner of cover repaired (well away from stamp). Even by the turn of the century, it is unusual to find DWI covers to areas away from the usual business centers. 2011 Facit value (in good condition) is SEK 3500 = \$510 [1/2011]. 195.00

1903 Bisect Covers

Four cent stamps were officially allowed to be bisected due to a shortage of two cent stamps. Use started 20 January 1903 and continued until 23 May on St. Thomas and 4 June on St. Croix (Christiansted and Frederiksted). Typical use is for the two cent domestic letter rate, however two cent foreign post card rate uses do exist (very scarce). Double weight printed matter items probably also exist, but are rare. Only one bisected example of the Perf 14 Printing I (ultramarine) Bicolor is recorded. However, the second printing of the Perf 14 is available. The Perf 12.75 4 cent Bicolor had two printings (green/blue vs blue) as well as various inverted frame positions of both colors; all exist bisected though the blue color is scarcer and the inverted frame examples are very scarce. The bisects are diagonal and are often collected in all four possible positions of each of the available printings. Additionally some collectors seek examples with all the different postmarks in use at the time. First day and last day uses are also sought. 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Shipping Company Stamps

These interesting stamps are often called Ship Letter Stamps. They were sold by the agents of ship operators and paid the postage on letters carried by commercial ships, usually when government mail service was not available. The DWI Shipping Company Stamps are listed in the annual Facit Specialized Catalog which I distribute and are most comprehensively listed in the beautiful 1976 handbook and catalog by S. Ringström and H.E. Tester The Private Ship Letter Stamps of the World, Part 1, The Caribbean which I have available.

I often have a wide range of Danish West Indies (as well as Danish, Finnish, Norwegian and Swedish) shipping company stamps in stock. These usually never make it to the website or price lists and are usually only available via approvals. Please be sure to let me know of your interests.

HAPAG - Hamburg American Packet Company

HAPAG Caribbean service started in 1870. One stamp design was issued in 1875; in 1879 a new printing was issued in slightly different colors. They were used until 1881. While I am not aware of any forgeries of these stamps, there were four reprints officially issued by the company: 1897, 1938, 1955, and 1975. The reprints are all perforated differently than the original stamps and have various differences in appearance, design, and paper.

The Virgin Islands Christmas Seals Fund issued very attractive perforated and imperforate Christmas Seal sheets from 1987 through 1999. In

some years, the perforated sheets exist with perforated and/or imperforate top (?) margins (similar to most Christmas Seals of Greenland and Faroe). For the 1988-1999 issues, there are also perforated (only one margin type) and imperforate "annual" seals which do NOT bear the legend "Christmas" or the year date -- these were issued for use throughout the year, not just during the Christmas season. In some years, the seal sheet includes illustrations of the original DWI Christmas Seals. Artist-signed sheets exist for all years (but are scarce). Progressive color proof sheet sets exist for some years. All of these seals can be quite difficult to obtain, even though they are not costly.
