## 1903 Bisect Covers

Four cent stamps were officially allowed to be bisected due to a shortage of two cent stamps. Use started 20 January 1903 and continued until 23 May on St. Thomas and 4 June on St. Croix (Christiansted and Frederiksted). Typical use is for the two cent domestic letter rate, however two cent foreign post card rate uses do exist (very scarce). Double weight printed matter items probably also exist, but are rare. Only one bisected example of the Perf 14 Printing I (ultramarine) Bicolor is recorded. However, the second printing of the Perf 14 is available. The Perf 12.754 cent Bicolor had two printings (greenblue vs blue) as well as various inverted frame positions of both colors; all exist bisected though the blue color is scarcer and the inverted frame examples are very scarce. The bisects are diagonal and are often collected in all four possible positions of each of the available printings. Additionally some collectors seek examples with all the different postmarks in use at the time. First day and last day uses are also sought. Because of the exciting nature of the bisects, they were also used on "cacheted" souvenir covers which are avidly sought after. I usually have more examples available than are shown on my website and in my price list. If you are seeking printings, positions, or postmarks not listed here, please inquire. They were sold by the agents of ship operators and paid the postage on letters carried by commercial ships, usually when government mail service was not available. The DWI Shipping Company Stamps are listed in the annual Facit Specialized Catalog which I distribute and are most comprehensively listed in the beautiful 1976 handbook and catalog by S. Ringström and H.E. Tester The Private Ship Letter Stamps of the World, Part 1, The Caribbean which I have available.

## U.S. Virgin Islands Christmas Seals

The Virgin Islands Christmas Seals Fund issued very attractive perforated and imperforate
Christmas Seal sheets from 1987 though 1999. In some years, the perforated sheets exist with perforated and/or imperforate top (?) margins (similar to most Christmas Seals of Greenland and Faroe). For the 1988-1999 issues, there are also perforated (only one margin type) and imperforate "annual" seals which do NOT bear the legend "Christmas" or the year date -- these were issued for use throughout the year, not just during the Christmas season. In some years, the seal sheet includes illustrations of the original DWI Christmas Seals. Artist-signed sheets exist for all years (but are scarce). Progressive color proof sheet sets exist for some years. All of these seals can be quite difficult to obtain, even though they are not costly. ## Labels

The DWI labels of which I am aware are all propaganda labels that either protest or support the sale of DWI to the U.S. The sale was proposed during WWI when the German government was also interested in DWI as a submarine base
(which is what the U.S. ended up building there, along with other installations). Prior to the negotiations with the U.S., as the result of a vote by the Danish legislature, there was to be a plebicite in DWI; these seals were propaganda leading up to that vote. Some versions of the labels are scarce. Labels canceled with properly dated Danish cancel are very scarce, but examples canceled in DWI are rare if they exist (I do not recall seeing any). Labels are extremely scarce to rare used on cover; they must either be tied by the postmark or the cover must show some other convincing relationship to the label.

The "DANSK VESTINDIEN PROTEST MOD SALGET" (Danish West Indies Protest Against The Sale) version is seldom seen. This seal was issued by the Dansk Vestindisk Samfund, which seems to have been based in København. I am aware of at least two printings: a) Brilliant colors colors with ultramarine text (though sometimes greenish blue, but that may be due to light exposure), on bright white chalk coated paper, perforation 11.5. b) Strong colors (but some not as bright as on the coated paper version) with dull greenish-blue text, on yellowish uncoated paper, perforation 11.5. Examples of either printing with full gum are extremely scarce; examples without defects are quite scarce.

The "PANAMA CANAL ST. THOMAS HARBOUR" version is seldom seen, perhaps because it was possibly produced outside of Denmark (based on the British English text) and thus not found in as many DWI collections. The Danish flag indicates that this was made in the pre-sale era. However, it is not clear if this is a supportive or protest seal, though the presence of the U.S. flag tends to indicate support (DWI Mails says "possibly promoting the sale"). I am aware of
only one printing: Perforation 11.5. I am not sure if the paper was originally coated paper. I have only seen example that have been soaked, but I suspect they were on chalk coated paper. Examples with full gum are extremely scarce; examples without defects are scarce. Imperforate examples exist, but are extremely scarce or rare.
